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- Red Maple, *Acer rubrum*. Deciduous tree, notable for its brilliant red Fall color and profuse display of small red flowers in the Spring. Native to east & central N. A.
- European Hornbeam, *Carpinus betula fastigiata*. Deciduous tree upright in habit. Native to Europe and Persia.
- Sycamore Maple, *Acer pseudoplatanus*. Deciduous tree with large coarse leaves having conspicuous veins. Native to Europe and western Asia.
- Robenia, *Robenia hispida*. Deciduous shrub, native to Virginia and Georgia.
- Callery Pear, *Pyrus calleryana*. Deciduous tree, notable for its white flowers in early May. Its Autumn color is red to glossy scarlet. Native habitat, China.
- Norway Maple, *Acer platanoides*. Deciduous tree with dense foliage. Notable for its early display of yellow-green flowers and yellow Fall color. Native to Europe and the Caucasus.
- Japanese Tree Lilac, *Syringa amurensis japonicum*. This deciduous tree is of special value because of the late bloom of its flowers. Native of Japan.
- White Ash, *Fraxinus americana*. Deciduous tree with compound leaves which have a yellow Fall color. Native of eastern U. S.
- Weeping Higan Cherry, *Prunus subhirtella pendula*. Deciduous tree with weeping branches which bear pink flowers in the Spring. Native of Japan.
- Flowering Dogwood, *Cornus florida*. Deciduous tree valued for its beautiful display of white flowers in the Spring. Native of eastern U. S.
- Flowering Crab Apple, *Malus "Red Jade."* Deciduous tree interesting for its pendulous branching habit and profuse scarlet fruit. Hybrid origin, introduced by Brooklyn B.G.
- Golden Larch, *Pseudolarix amabilis*. Deciduous tree with needle-like foliage very similar to the Larch. Its cones are of ornamental value. Native of China.
- Chinese Witch-Hazel, *Hamamelis mollis*. Deciduous shrub valued for its large fragrant flowers. Native of central China.
- Amur Maackia, *Maackia amurensis*. Deciduous tree valued for its late summer flowers. Leaves are compound.
- Fragrant Viburnum, *Viburnum carlcephalum*. Deciduous shrub with coarse foliage and fragrant flowers. Of hybrid origin.
- Japanese Clethra, *Clethra barbinervis*. Deciduous shrub valued for its handsome flowers in late July. Introduced in 1870. Native of Japan.
- Hardy Orange, *Poncirus trifoliata*. Deciduous shrub or tree. Sometimes used as a hedge because of its dense growth and prominent spines. Native to north China.
- Horse Chestnut, *Aesculus discolor mollis*. Small deciduous tree having compound leaves and bright red flowers. Native to Georgia and Texas.
- Common Lilac, *Syringa vulgaris*. Deciduous shrub valued for its fragrant flowers in Mid-May. Natural habitat south-eastern Europe.
- Border Forsythia, *Forsythia intermedia*. Deciduous shrub often used as a screening plant. Grown for its bright yellow spring flowers. Hybrid origin.
- Japanese Dogwood, *Cornus Kousa*. Deciduous tree with white flowers in the Spring and raspberry-like red fruit in late Summer. From Japan and Korea.
- Ground Euonymus, *Euonymus radicans nana*. Broad leafed evergreen used as a ground cover or a screening plant. Native of Japan.
- European Mountain Ash, *Sorbus aucuparia*. Deciduous tree with bright red berries in the Fall. Native to Europe, western Asia and Siberia.

American Arborvitae, *Thuja occidentalis*. Narrow leafed evergreen with scale-like, flat foliage. The overall habit is columnar. Native to eastern North America.

Deodar Cedar, *Cedrus deodora*. Narrow leafed evergreen with gracefully pendulous branches and having needle-like foliage, often in bunches. Native to Himalayas.

Pfitzer's Juniper, *Juniperus chinensis pfitzeriana*. Narrow leafed evergreen shrub having sharp, prickly foliage. Overall plant has feathery texture. Germany.

Norway Spruce, *Picea abies*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a pyramidal habit, native to north and central Europe and cultivated in eastern North America.

Scarlet Firethorn, *Pyracantha coccinea*. Deciduous shrub with bright red berries in the Fall. Native to Italy and western Asia.

Hiryu Azalia, *Rhododendron obtusum*. Broad leafed evergreen shrub valued for its orange-red flowers in mid-May. Native of Japan.

Colorado Blue Spruce, *Picea pungens glauca*. Narrow leafed evergreen with blueish-green needles and stiff, dense foliage. Native of Rocky Mts., Utah and New Mexico.

Colorado Spruce, *Picea pungens*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a stiff pyramidal habit, native to Utah and New Mexico.

Canadian Hemlock, *Tsuga canadensis*. Narrow leafed evergreen with small needle-like leaves and gracefully drooping branches.

Moss Sawara Cypress, *Chamaecyparis pisifera squarosa*. Narrow leafed evergreen with feathery, scale-like, blueish-green foliage. Native of Japan.

Yoshino Cherry, *Prunus yedoensis*. Deciduous tree valued for its white flowers in late April. Overall habit is flat topped and bushy. Cultivated in Japan.

Chinese Wisteria, *Wisteria sinensis*. Deciduous twining vine with blue-violet flowers in dense, pendulous racemes in late May. Native of China.

Fragrant Viburnum, *Viburnum carlesii*. Deciduous shrub grown for its very fragrant flowers in mid-May. Native of Korea.

Double-Fill Viburnum, *Viburnum plicatum tomentosum*. Deciduous shrub with almost horizontally spreading branches with white flowers.

Arrow Wood, *Viburnum dentatum*. Deciduous upright bushy shrub with straight branches. Native to eastern North America.

Japanese Barberry, *Berberis thunbergii*. Much branched deciduous shrub, branches with many spines. Introduced from Japan about 1864.

Vanhoutte Spirea, *Spiraea vanhouttei*. Deciduous shrub having pure white flowers in flat clusters. Its overall habit is gracefully arching. Hybrid origin.

Dawn Redwood, *Metasequoia glyptostroboides*. Deciduous tree, the foliage of which consists of needles. Rapid growing. Overall habit is pyramidal. Native of China.

Giant Sequoia, *Sequoia giganteum*. Narrow leafed evergreen with an open habit. Some of these trees are among the oldest living things; some are 4000 years old. Native of California.
