

AREA D

Norway Spruce, *Picea abies*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a pyramidal habit and pendulous secondary branches. Native to n. and central Europe, cultivated e. No. Amer.

Weeping Higan Cherry, *Prunus subhirtella pendula*. Deciduous tree with weeping branches which bear pink flowers in the Spring. Native to Japan.

Sugar Maple, *Acer saccharinum*. Deciduous tree with dense foliage and yellow to orange Fall color. Native to eastern North America.

Dawn Redwood, *Metasequoia glyptostroboides*. Deciduous tree, the foliage of which consists of needles. Rapid growing. The overall habit is pyramidal. China.

Colorado Spruce, *Picea pungens*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a stiffly pyramidal habit. Native to Utah and New Mexico.

Willow Oak, *Quercus phellos*. Deciduous tree with a fine texture and yellowish autumn color. Native to eastern seaboard and Gulf states.

Siberian Hardnut, *Juglans sieboldiana*. Deciduous tree having large, round green colored fruit in clusters. Native to Japan.

Horse Chestnut, *Aesculus lutea*. Deciduous tree resembling the common Chinese horse chestnut and of hybrid origin.

Arnold Crab Apple, *Malus arnoldiana*. Deciduous tree prized for its pink flowers and yellow and red fruit. Of hybrid origin.

European Larch, *Larix decidua*. Narrow leafed, deciduous tree having conifer-like needles which it drops at the end of the season. Native to n. and central Europe.

Arrow Wood, *Viburnum dentatum*. Deciduous shrub with opposite leaves which are notched on the margin. It has creamy white flower clusters and glossy red autumn color. Native to eastern U. S.

Canadian Hemlock, *Tsuga canadensis*. Narrow leafed evergreen with small needle-like leaves and gracefully drooping branches.

Japanese Snowbell, *Styrax japonica*. Deciduous, wide spreading tree or shrub, rather dense with graceful, small waxy white pendulous flowers in early June. China & Japan.

Rose, *Rosa floribunda*. Deciduous shrub grown for its white, fragrant flowers and as a screening plant. Native of central China.

Vanhoutte Spirea, *Spiraea vanhouttei*. Deciduous shrub having pure white flowers in flat clusters. Its overall habit is gracefully arching. Hybrid origin.

Mentor Barberry, *Berberis mentorensis*. Deciduous shrub, the younger leaves of which are spiny, a cultivar which originated before 1854.

Shrub Althea, *Hibiscus syriacus*. Deciduous shrub prized for its white flowers in August. It blooms at a time when few other woody plants are in bloom. China & India.

Spreading Euonymus, *Euonymus patens*. Semi-evergreen shrub having pinkish to red fruit in October. Native to eastern and central China.

Regel Privet, *Ligustrum obtusifolium regelianum*. Deciduous shrub having pendulous branches and black fruit. Native to Japan.

Wintergreen Barberry, *Berberis julianae*. Evergreen shrub with spines and bluish-black berries. Native to central China.

Oriental Arborvitae, *Thuja orientalis*. Narrow leafed evergreen shrub with lustrous, scale-like foliage usually arranged in planes, the edges of which face the outside of the plant. Native to northern China and Korea.

American Arborvitae, *Thuja occidentalis*. Narrow leafed evergreen with scale-like, flat foliage. The overall habit is columnar. Native to eastern North America.

Japanese Barberry, *Berberis thunbergii*. Much branched deciduous shrub, branches with many spines. Native to Japan.

Pfitzer's Juniper, *Juniperus chinensis pfitzeriana*. Narrow leafed evergreen shrub having sharp, prickly foliage. The overall plant has a feathery texture. Originated in Germany.

Common Privet, *Ligustrum vulgare*. Deciduous shrub used as a hedge plant. Europe.

Douglas Fir, *Pseudotsuga taxifolia*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a densely pyramidal habit and horizontal branching. Native to Rocky Mts. and Pacific coast.

Chinese Wisteria, *Wisteria sinensis*. Deciduous twining vine valued for its blue-violet, slightly fragrant flowers which hang down. Native of China.

Scarlet Firethorn, *Pyracantha coccinea*. Deciduous shrub with bright, red berries in the Fall. Native to Italy and western Asia.

Border Forsythia, *Forsythia intermedia*. Deciduous shrub often used as a screening plant. It is grown for its bright yellow Spring flowers and is of hybrid origin.

Winter Honeysuckle, *Lonicera fragrantissima*. Semi-evergreen valued for its foliage and very fragrant flowers.

Double-flowered Mazzard Cherry, *Prunus avium plena*. Deciduous tree with white, double flowers in early May. Native of Europe.

AREA E

Black Willow, *Salix nigra*. Deciduous tree. Very graceful. May reach considerable size. Native to northeastern U. S.

Silver Maple, *Acer saccharinum*. Deciduous tree having leaves with silvery white undersides, deeply cut and with gray-white bark. Native to eastern North America.

Amur Cork Tree, *Phellodendron amurense*. Deciduous tree with deeply fissured, corklike bark. Native of northern China.

Sycamore or American Plane, *Platanus occidentalis*. Deciduous tree with large leaves and exfoliating colorful season. Native to northeastern North America.

Redbud Crab Apple, *Malus zumi calocarpa*. Deciduous tree, one of the best crab apples for ornamental fruit. Flowers white in early May. Of hybrid origin.

Japanese Flowering Crab, *Malus floribunda*. Deciduous tree having white flowers in early May and yellow and red fruit. Its habit is rounded and densely branched. Japan

Leather Leaf Viburnum, *viburnum rhytidophyllum*. Deciduous shrub with handsome, wrinkled leaves. Native to central and western China.

Scarlet Firethorn, *Pyracantha coccinea*. Deciduous shrub with bright red berries in the Fall. Native to Italy and western Asia.

English Holly, *Ilex aquifolium*. Broad leafed evergreen with dark green lustrous leaves which are spiny. Native to Europe and Asia.

Silk Tree, *Albizia julibrissin*. Deciduous tree with very fine, compound leaves. The flowers are light pink and silk-like in texture. Native habitat, Persia to cen. China

White Ash, *Fraxinus americana*. Deciduous tree with compound leaves. Fall color is yellow. Native of eastern U. S.

Oregon Grape Holly Mahonia, *Mahonia aquifolium*. Semi-evergreen shrub with lustrous dark green foliage. Its native habitat extends from British Columbia to Oregon.

Common Buckthorn, *Rhamnus cathartica*. Small, deciduous tree, native to Europe and Asia.

Redbud Crab Apple, *Malus zumi calcarpa*. Deciduous tree. One of the best crab apples for ornamental fruit, flowers white in early May. Of hybrid origin.

Douglas Fir, *Pseudotsuga taxifolia*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a densely pyramidal habit and horizontal branching. Native of Rocky Mts. and Pacific coast.

Scarlet Firethorn, *Pyracantha coccinea*. Deciduous shrub with bright red berries in the fall. Native to Italy and western Asia.

Flowering Dogwood, *Cornus florida*. Deciduous tree, valued for its beautiful display of white flowers in the Spring. Native of eastern U. S.

Pink Indigo, *Indigofera amblyantha*. Deciduous shrub valued for the length of bloom of its flowers. Native of China.

Common Witch-hazel, *Hamamelis virginia*. Deciduous shrub valued for flowers which bloom in October. Also valued for its bright yellow autumn color. Native of eastern and central U. S.

Fragrant Viburnum, *Viburnum carlcephalum*. Deciduous shrub having opposite leaves and fragrant flowers. A horticultural cultivar.

Common Horse Chestnut, *Aesculus hippocastanum*. Deciduous tree with compound leaves and upright floral spikes in May. Native to Europe.

Golden Larch, *Pseudolarix amabilis*. Deciduous tree with long needles resembling the larch. The cones are most interesting in the Fall. Native to eastern China.

Japanese Pagoda Tree, *Sophora japonica*. Deciduous tree with compound leaves and white, pea-like flowers in large pyramidal upright clusters in August. China and Korea

Colorado Blue Spruce, *Picea pungens glauca*. A stiffly pyramidal narrow leafed evergreen, with dense bluish-green needles. Native habitat is Rocky Mts., Utah to N. M.

Pin Oak, *Quercus palustris*. Deciduous tree with a fine textured foliage and with its lower branches hanging down. Autumn color scarlet. Native to central and mid-east US

Norway Spruce, *Picea abies*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a pyramidal habit and pendulous branches, still while young but often graceful at maturity.

English Hawthorn, *Crataegus oxyacantha "Paulii"* Deciduous thorny tree or shrub with double bright scarlet flowers in May. Native to Europe and northern Africa.

Dawn Redwood, *Metasequoia glyptostroboides*. Deciduous tree with loose, open, needle-like foliage. Native to China.

American Arborvitae, *Thuja occidentalis*. Narrow leafed evergreen with scale-like, flat foliage. Overall habit is columnal. Native to eastern North America.

Colorado Spruce, *Picea pungens*. Narrow leafed evergreen with a stiffly pyramidal habit. Native to Utah and New Mexico.

Lilac, *Syringa vulgaris*. Deciduous. Valued for its fragrant flowers in mid-May. Natural habitat southeastern Europe.

Shrub Althea, *Hibiscus syriacus*. Deciduous shrub prized for its white flowers in August, blooming at a time when few other woody plants are in bloom. China & India

Arrow-wood Viburnum, *Viburnum dentatum*. Deciduous shrub having creamy white flowers in early June. A vigorous shrub. Native habitat, eastern Asia.

Roas "Robin Hood" Deciduous shrub sometimes used as a massing plant because of its vigorous growth. It is valued for its pink flowers and is of hybrid origin.

Wintergreen Barberry, *Berberis julianae*. Evergreen shrub with spines and bluish-black berries. Native to central China.
